EMS Course Changes for Fall 2006

EMT-CME Core Refresher – This course has been lengthened to include the 6 hours of “optional” education in Geriatrics and Weapons of Mass Destruction. Students may opt out of these sessions if they do not need them to complete their CME training, but many students have requested that we include them.

EMT Original – Academy Style – EMS 110-515 – This version of the NYS EMT Curriculum has been designed to allow a student to become certified in only 6 weeks of instruction. The class will start October 2nd and test on November 16th. It will meet Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday from 8:30 to 3:30 with an hour lunch break. The 24 hour per week of instruction balances the need to offer condensed classroom instruction with the time required to complete reading and enrichment activities outside of the classroom.

Operational Management for EMS – EMS 141-010 – Have you ever wondered what to do when you are faced with a problem as an EMS Supervisor? This course is designed to teach current and future EMS Operations Officers how to approach many EMS situations including incident investigations, large event planning, agency recertification, and provider wellness. The material is designed to be immediately applicable to the operation of an EMS organization of any type. This course will be taught using two-thirds class room interaction and one-third on line using SUNY-Learnnet.

Public Safety Leadership Development – PST 265-181 – With the blizzard of NIMS and WMD training requirements, the human side of Public Safety is often ignored. However, time and again we learn that if we can't effectively motivate and lead our people then all our technical training can be applied. No agency can effectively achieve its goals without a clear vision and a defined path. Effective leadership helps remove barriers that prevent agencies from reaching their objectives. This course is designed to help aspiring and current leaders develop a vision and the means to achieve it in an effective manner. The course will use personal development tools, case studies, and role plays to help students learn key concepts to improve their performance and the operation of their agency.

Notes:

- A- Challenge practical exams for these courses will be established at the first meeting based on needs of the students and the program
- B- EMS 110-010 and EMS 110-414 are offered at concurrent times. MCC staff may reassign students between sections to keep enrollment even in each section.
- C- This course is "academy style" with four 6-hour session per week with a one hour lunch break each day.
- D- Students must be enrolled in the CME Based Recertification program with the NYS DOH. This course includes 24 hours of core content and 6 hours of "optional" education.
