

**Job Posting:**

**Fire Marshal**

The Town of Brighton anticipates an opening in June, 2007 for a full-time Fire Marshal. This is a competitive-class position under the Civil Service Law, and any appointee will have provisional status pending the test results. The assignment is for a 35-hour workweek, Monday through Friday, but is expected to be on call 24/7 to respond to fire scenes. Salary \$47,156 to \$60,187.

Minimum Qualifications: Must be a NYS-certified Code Enforcement Official, and must satisfy the combination of training and experience as required by Civil Service.

Desired qualifications: At least two years of full-time experience (or its part-time equivalent) in fire and building code enforcement; plus either at least one year of experience as a paid firefighter, one year of experience as a Level I NYS Fire Investigator and/or five year's of experience as a volunteer firefighter.

Description of duties: The Fire Marshal administers and enforces the NYS Code and related Town ordinances (including property maintenance), and supervises two assistant fire marshals as they assist him in the necessary inspections. He investigates all fires involving injury or substantial loss of property. He also acts as Emergency Disaster Coordinator, Employee Safety and Loss Prevention Coordinator, and Secretary to the Public Safety Committee.
