Brockport firefighters are banding together once again to support one of their own in their time of need. Firefighter Harry Hamlin and his wife, Deb are on their way to Durham, NC to undergo strength building and prepare Deb for a double lung transplant once she is placed on the transplant list at Duke Hospital.

Deb was diagnosed with a rare debilitating respiratory disease that has diminished her breathing capacity to the point that this surgery has become necessary for any prognosis of long term survival. The Hamlins hope to only be away for three to four months to accomplish the strength building and subsequent surgery. Housing costs while in Durham are not being taken care of by medical insurance, so Harry's comrades in the fire service hope to raise funds through this benefit dinner to offset those expenses.
